

country. It then attributes a score from 1-100 to the building which represents its energy efficiency coefficient. By requiring this information at lease or sale, municipalities can help the real estate industry extract a return on energy efficiency.

1B. Commercial Building Energy Performance Requirement: The counties or municipalities may require or incentivize commercial building owners to reach a minimum score for energy efficiency through the Portfolio Manager systems.

1C. Home Energy Assessment Requirement at the Time of Sale: The counties or municipalities may require or incentivize home energy assessment at the time of a residential sale. This requirement would provide energy efficiency information to customers at a moment of opportunity for retrofit investments.

1D. Building Energy Assessment Requirement at the Time of Permit: Blaine County's 2009 ordinance #2011-02 requires that Home Energy Ratings (HERs)¹⁵ be undertaken when large additions or new structures are planned. Perhaps Camas County should consider adopting a similar ordinance.

1E. Improve Permitting Process to Incentivize Building Retrofits: The counties or municipalities could enhance opportunities for building retrofits during "intervention points" in the permitting process in the same way that the City of Hailey has already done:

- Require energy assessments with utilities early in the permitting process.
- Include greenhouse gas emissions analysis in SEPA documents.
- Institute "fee-bate" provisions, whereby building permit applicants who plan more efficient remodels or new construction can earn a discount on permit fees.
- Prioritize permitting for projects planning to achieve greater energy efficiency.
- Permitting green building at the time of sale and building energy policy into the building design and development

Policy Initiative Action 2—Mobility and Transportation Alternatives

The public transportation system provides another major opportunity for the Wood River Valley Region to build on its New Energy Cities program. The use of fossil fuels for transportation is a substantial component of the Wood River Valley's energy use and cost. Three fundamental strategies can reduce this impact—making fewer, cleaner, and more cost-efficient trips.

¹⁵ A Home Energy Rating is a measurement of a home's energy efficiency, used primarily in the United States. Home energy ratings can be used for either existing homes or new homes. A home energy rating of an existing home allows a homeowner to receive a report listing options for upgrading a home's energy efficiency. The homeowner may then use the report to determine the most effective ways to upgrade the home's energy efficiency. A home energy rating of a new home allows buyers to compare the energy efficiency of homes they are considering buying.

Policy Initiative Action 3—Codes and Zoning

Identification of zoning barriers and the revision of various jurisdictions' zoning laws to make renewable resources easier to install.

- ≈ All communities to undertake implementation of the Rocky Mountain Land Institute sustainability planning model.
- ≈ Attempt to unify and streamline the various jurisdictions' codes to provide certainty in the marketplace for builders and ensure that building doesn't go places it isn't desired

2A. Land Use

Land use goes hand in hand with reducing the number of vehicle trips generated and the amount of fossil fuels consumed through vehicle use within the entire Wood River Valley region. Comprehensive plans and zoning provisions can bring about land use patterns to encourage greater density, mixed-use, infill, workforce housing near employment, transportation demand management strategies, transit-oriented neighborhoods, and pedestrian/bike connectivity, all of which play a role in getting people out of cars and utilizing alternatives such as walking, biking, carpooling, and utilizing the public transit system. Zoning codes should be looked at as an important tool to encourage patterns of development that support mobility and transportation alternatives and should be evaluated by the communities in the region.

2B. Complete Streets: Wood River Valley Region cities' staff should evaluate each road project to determine if the infrastructure meets the needs of pedestrians, bicyclists and transit riders, as well as vehicles. (The City of Hailey has a draft in place for Woodside for Complete Streets improvements).

2C. Electrification of the Transportation System: Shifting the transportation fuel source from fossil to clean electricity is one of the most effective carbon reduction strategies in the Wood River Valley. The Wood River Valley Region cities should evaluate their building codes to determine if there are policies that would enhance charging station infrastructure.

- ≈ Charging station mandates for multifamily construction.
- ≈ PHEV or EV preference for new city-owned vehicles.

Mountain Rides is an excellent public-private partnership interested in innovation, who should be engaged in this discussion.



Community Engagement

An informed and active community is vital to creating catalytic projects, and to embracing the policy and program decisions necessary for success. A robust, sustained outreach and education effort has to receive priority attention for any community aspiring to become a New Energy City.

During the Energy Summit, action items for community engagement were not as developed as others, so more work is recommended in this area once the catalytic projects are prioritized.

Community Engagement Action 1—Community Engagement around Energy Savings

- Craft an energy literacy framework that aligns with the vision and goals that the Wood River Valley Region chooses to pursue
- Establish the baseline of energy use in Wood River Valley Region that will be measured and monitored by reviewing available data from utilities
- Set targets for reduction and savings

Community Engagement Action 2—Communications and Messaging

Effort should be made to develop messages to different audiences around the clean energy initiatives that the Wood River Valley Region is embracing and why.

- Begin developing central themes and brand identity
- Segment audiences, identify how they align with themes and brand
- Create customized messages
- Add in specific examples to make them tangible and understandable

Community Engagement Action 3—Voluntary Fee-Bate Program

At the time of the Energy Summit, it appeared that there was an opportunity to kick off a community mobilization campaign when Idaho Power announced that it would be returning money to rate payers, if it at the same time informs customers about all of the clean energy initiatives that the valley is embracing and offers them the opportunity to bank their rebates in a fund to make those initiatives possible. Research needs to be done to see if this is still a viable action.

- Work with Idaho Power to determine how to make this program happen
- If possible, get permission from Idaho Power to work with the customer database to target the Wood River Valley Region residents with a message asking them if they would be interested in contributing their rate reduction to the project.



Next Steps

The New Energy Cities team and the Wood River Valley Region leaders will review this document to refine and complete the Phase I process for prioritization, resource allocation, timelines, and responsibilities. Top of the list is to address the question of governance and project direction going forward.

After the team is in place that will guide the Wood River Valley Region's Clean Energy initiatives, decisions need to be made about which catalytic projects to start with and how they should be scoped and financed. Next attention will need to shift to public engagements strategies. When the projects, policy, financing, and engagement next steps are identified, the region will move on to Phase II implementation.

Overextending early in the process would undermine the overall success of the Action Plan, and so clear focus areas are needed in the beginning. We recommend that the Wood River Valley Region focus on narrowing the choices among the action areas listed in this action plan. In each action area, the region could proceed by developing a workplan, determining responsibility, assigning tasks, and determining funding for successful implementation.



Phase II: Implementation—12 Months

The second phase of this Action Plan centers on getting catalytic projects started, while building the critical relationships and resources needed to deliver these projects successfully and use them to inform future efforts. Phase II is focused on getting early projects implemented, so that the results of these projects can help shape longer-term policies and reinforce the emerging approach to community engagement:

1. Carry out the set of projects that will produce success to build upon, as well as data to inform future projects.
2. Roll out a communications strategy, developed in Phase I, with ongoing resources to ensure a consistent message and collaboration with community partners.
3. Refine the potential financing options for future projects, with an orientation toward testing and exploring priority options in order to resolve questions on legal structures, accounting and tax considerations, and risk analysis.

The transition from Phase I to II can be challenging and will reflect the Wood River Valley Region's leaders' ability to mobilize people and resources to prioritize the projects and goals that have been articulated and flesh out the desired projects' scope, scale, and financing.

Phase II should serve as the planning cycle for developing the Phase III timeline, preparing the community for an extension of the pilot projects across the community, refining the financing strategies and models for ongoing, long-term implementation. In addition, this process would

create the capacity to monitor progress, measure impacts, assess costs and benefits, and inform adjustments and new directions.



Phase III: Refine and Scale Up-18 Months

In Phase III, the Wood River Valley Region will get feedback on the impacts of the early pilot projects, and, presuming success, will have extensive political support due to partnership development and engagement with the community. Phase III becomes a threshold step, in which the community moves beyond pilot projects and into an ongoing, consistent implementation program of defined projects over a set period of time.

Phase III provides an 18-month period during which the community could strive to solidify the policy foundation for the next 20 years of project implementation.

1. Create and seed the community's finance and investment vehicles, with a strategy for ongoing funding or re-capitalization.
2. Develop a basket of incentives and requirements to effectively gain universal participation in efficiency, renewable energy, and infrastructure programs.
3. Forge lasting partnerships that ensure that progress is measured, results are communicated broadly, and the program is subject to routine review and analysis for improvements.
4. Invest in human resources to manage implementation of the array of activities, and institutionalize that capacity with stable funding and succession planning.

In Phase III, the Wood River Valley Region leaders should consider developing a strategy of widespread deployment of energy efficiency, distributed renewable energy, electric vehicle infrastructure, and smart grid technologies that could include the following components. Phase III is too far out to be specific about what might be embraced at this stage of its New Energy City plan, but we feel it is useful to highlight some of the directions that could be explored:

A Long-Term High Performance Building Strategy

A future of very efficient buildings that produce their own energy and are part of an intelligent energy network will require aggressive and consistent efforts over time. Efforts should be made to put building codes in place that would allow for more green building branding, and that development standards and the county's comprehensive plan need to be revised with energy in mind.

A Long-Term Financing Approach

Local jurisdictions that develop innovative policies to reduce the risks associated with investment and add certainty to potential investors should be expected to gain access to long-term, patient sources of capital.

Distributed Renewable Energy Generation

A significant element of distributed generation could be addressed within a high-performance building strategy. However, substantial additional opportunities exist for communities to accelerate and deepen the role that distributed renewable sources could play in their overall approach.

Smart Grid Infrastructure

The Wood River Valley Region should integrate closely with Idaho Power and its smart grid technology deployment to maximize the benefits of deploying various smart grid technologies.

Electric Vehicle Infrastructure and Deployment

The Wood River Valley Region should integrate closely with Idaho Power and its electric vehicle deployment plans.

Expand Concept of Energy

Embrace a broader concept of sustainability and how it relates to energy and money to include food, recycling, preservation of trees, transit, and water.



Ongoing Recommendations

Throughout all Phases of the Wood River Valley Region's New Energy Cities Action Plan, it is important to keep the following three ongoing requirements in mind at all times:

Engagement – A consistent, sustained commitment by elected leadership to invest in engaging the community to fully understand the path and collective benefits to this New Energy System, and to support the needed policies, programs, and investment resources is crucial. This level of collaboration with the community is a significant step beyond traditional engagement efforts, and is critical to success.

Experimentation with New Policies and Programs – New policies and programs are needed, some of which will exceed expectations while others may fall short. The need to experiment and refine our approaches is a fundamental component of the leadership challenge and a defining element of a New Energy City. Such an approach means that elected officials will have to communicate effectively about the process for trying new ideas and refining them over time.

Institutional Capacity – Ongoing resources and training will be needed to support the Wood River Valley's new energy efforts. The community and key partners, such as utilities, nonprofits and businesses, all need a focal point for collaboration, and need to be supported by this focal

point in order for their efforts to consistently contribute to progress and support all of the innovations in clean energy that the valley has such a strong appetite to explore.



Conclusion

Climate Solutions’ New Energy Cities program works with innovative city and county leaders that wish to be early adopters of the integrated clean energy system that will bring economic development to their communities, reduce greenhouse gas emissions, and leverage public investment with large-scale private investment.



1. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Randy Hall at 5:30pm.

2. Presentation of Ketchum Fire Department Commendations

*Also Present: Sun Valley Councilor Nils Ribi
Sun Valley Councilor Michelle Griffith*

Ketchum Fire Chief Mike Elle related the story of how individual emergency service personnel from Blaine County Dispatch, the Ketchum Fire Department, Sun Valley Fire Department, and Sun Valley Police Department worked together to revive Sun Valley resident and local businessman Rex Willows-Munro. They continued to monitor his life systems until he arrived at St. Luke's Wood River Emergency Room. Willows-Munro is now alive and well and back to work, thanks to their efforts.

Ketchum Mayor Randy Hall and Sun Valley Councilor Michelle Griffith awarded plaques of commendation to Ketchum Probationary Firefighter Dustin Coleman, Ketchum Captain/Advanced EMT Tom Ancona, Ketchum Lieutenant/Paramedic Ed Binnie, Ketchum Fire Chief/Paramedic Mike Elle, Ketchum Senior Engineer/Advanced EMT Eric Daigh, Ketchum Engineer/EMT Tann Robrahn, Engineer/EMT Brian Tierney, Ketchum Probationary Firefighter Ben Varner; Sun Valley firefighter Corey Allen, Sun Valley Acting Assistant Chief/EMT Mal Prior; and Sun Valley Police Officer 4400 Aaron McCarver.

Willows-Munro, along with his family members, thanked each person who worked to save his life.

Mayor Hall commended every Ketchum and Sun Valley firefighter and police officer, whether involved in this incident or not, for their care and expertise in keeping residents of the Wood River Valley safe.

3. Communications from Mayor and Councilmembers

Council President Baird Gourlay said he and Councilor Michael David had recently joined firefighters in a Fire Ops in Meridian. As part of the ops, Gourlay entered a 850 degree room, and has a new respect for firefighters.

Councilor David said he appreciated learning about the technology, and seeing firefighters and paramedics use their training, expertise and knowledge. They extricated a dummy out of a car, and did CRP on the dummy in the ambulance on the way to the hospital.

Mayor Hall admonished *Mountain Express* reporter Rebecca Meany for leaving the Wood River Valley ... a second time. She will be missed.

4. Request for funding for Summer Marley in the Mountains 2012 event

Mayor Hall said miscommunication resulted in Ketchum giving Danny Walton \$5,000 for the Summer Marley in the Mountains event. Ketchum had already given Walton \$5,000 for Winter Marley in the Mountains. Mayor Hall discussed the situation with Walton, who appreciated all the support from Ketchum and was glad to accept \$2,500 from Ketchum this time.

Council President Baird Gourlay moved to amend his prior motion to give Danny Walton \$5,000. Ketchum will give Walton a reduced amount of \$2,500 for the summer Marley in the Mountains event. Motion seconded by Councilor Nina Jonas, and passed unanimously.

5. Sun Valley Marketing Alliance Report

Sun Valley Marketing Alliance Board President Jake Peters represents the City of Ketchum on the SVMA Board. Peters had four goals when he accepted the appointment, and has fulfilled three of them: create a structure that the cities of Ketchum and Sun Valley would fund, devise a simple and correct strategy, and find an executive director. Peters wants to present some options to the City of Ketchum to accomplish his fourth goal to procure long-term funding, so SVMA doesn't have to ask the two cities for annual funding.

Peters said he had given the Mayor a letter of resignation when he accepted the appointment, and would quit any time the Council wanted him to. He told the new Council he served at their discretion. Once a long-term funding strategy is established, Peters feels the cities should find someone with more marketing experience.

Mayor Hall commended Peters and the SVMA Board for accomplishing three of their four goals. Councilor Gourlay looks forward to finding a creative way to devise long-term funding, which may be a percentage of the local option tax. The Council thanked Peters for the work and effort he had put into the SVMA.

Peters said the SVMA's goal is to make people in the United States more aware of Sun Valley; and to see they are treated well once they get here.

6. Communications from the public

- Phyllis Shafran asked Council to consider allowing Ketchum department heads to present their "wish list" to Council in a public budget meeting

Mayor Hall said all departments now put their "wish list" into the Capital Improvement Plan.

- Shafran said the Walkability project should be a Capital Improvement project.

Mayor Hall feels there is a lot of public support for the Walkability plan, but the project will be scrutinized and ultimately accepted or rejected by Council.

- Shafran asked if department-provided services for special events were a line item in the various department budgets.

Marks said the City had never tried to figure out the cost of services that different departments contributed to special events.

- Mickey Garcia said at-will employees deserve to have collective bargaining power. He hoped new Council members would refrain from discussing such things in secret meetings.

7. Communications from the Press

No communications from the press at this time.

8. Wastewater Buildings Stucco Resurfacing Contract for Services

Ketchum Wastewater Plant Supervisor Dave Taylor asked Council to approve the low bid for a capital improvement contract for stucco work at the waste plant.

Council President Baird Gourlay moved to approve the contract for services for resurfacing of four wastewater buildings with Northwest Plastering and Construction Inc. in the amount of \$14,900. Motion seconded by Commissioner Nina Jonas, and passed unanimously.

9. Utility Box Art Project Contract for Services Amendment

Ketchum Parks and Recreation Director Jen Smith said the Idaho Commission for the Arts awarded Ketchum double the amount requested for Mark Johnson's advisory services for the utility box project.

Council President Baird Gourlay moved to amend the Utility Box Art Project Contract for Services with Mark Johnson to include the additional \$2,000 provided by Idaho Council on the Arts funding. Motion seconded by Commissioner Nina Jonas, and passed unanimously.

10. City Hall Roof Repair Contract for Services

Ketchum Fire Chief Mike Elle said Ketchum City Hall was built in the 1970s. A severe leak in the roof resulted in rotting sheet rock falling on top of an ambulance. The solid membrane and plywood roof needs to be replaced. The old building continues to require expensive repair every year to remain useful as it is, which will come out of the City's general fund.

Council President Baird Gourlay moved to approve the City Hall Roof Repair Contract for Services with Scott Miley Roofing, not to exceed \$35,987, which represents the bid amount of \$32,487 plus a \$3,500 contingency for plywood sheeting, if needed. Motion seconded by Councilor Michael David, and passed unanimously.

11. Updated U.S. Bank Master Services Agreement

Council President Baird Gourlay moved to approve the updated Master Services Agreement with U.S. Bank. Motion seconded by Commissioner Nina Jonas, and passed unanimously

12. CONSENT CALENDAR

- b. Recommendation to approve current bills and payroll summary
