

TRANSIT INFORMATION

A year round transit system with routes serving downtown Ketchum, Warm Springs, River Run, Sun Valley, Hailey and Bellevue is available 7 days a week for your convenience. Discover this easy way to get to Ketchum and around town.

Weekday Valley Service

Bellevue north to Ketchum and Sun Valley, buses leave downtown Bellevue on the half hour from 6:00 am to 8:30 am with stops in Woodside, Hailey, East Fork, the Meadows and St. Luke's. Two mid day runs leave Bellevue at 11:00 am and 1:30 pm.

Ketchum/Sun Valley south to Bellevue

Buses leave downtown Ketchum at 3:15, 4:15, 4:50, 5:25, 6:15 and 7:25 pm with stops at St. Luke's, the Meadows, Hailey, Woodside and Bellevue. Two mid day runs leave downtown Ketchum at 10:15 am and 12:45 pm.

PARKING ENFORCEMENT

Parking time limits are strictly enforced year round by Community Service Officers to establish consistency, predictability and dependability.

The Ketchum Municipal Code prohibits a car from being parked more than 2 hours per block per day in restricted parking areas; this is to discourage people who need to park all day from shuffling their car between spots that should be available for customers.

The first citation is a warning issued as a courtesy to customers and visitors who may be unaware of the parking restrictions in downtown. The second citation is \$25.00. The third citation, and each citation after, is \$52.00

Failure to pay a parking citation within 15 days from the date of issue will result in a \$5.00 late fee. After 365 days without a citation issued against your vehicle, your vehicle returns to warning status.

To promote a business friendly downtown, the City of Ketchum wants to keep the most convenient parking spaces available for customers.

Business owners and their employees are encouraged to park in unrestricted locations; this will free up the most convenient spaces for customers.

...BUT WE WOULDN'T BE IN BUSINESS WITHOUT EMPLOYEES!

There are 933 restricted spaces in downtown and 990 unrestricted spaces. This map shows the locations of unrestricted spaces - all within a 5 to 10 minute walk of the center of downtown!

Five public parking areas are available for parking. Look for this symbol. → 

Two of the public parking areas are available for all day parking:

- the east end of Fourth Street
- the south end of East Avenue

TRIP REDUCTION
