### **Sidewalk Repairs to Start Monday** *597 Potential "Trip Hazards" Identified*

KETCHUM, Idaho -- Repair work will begin Monday, Oct. 6, on 594 possible "trip hazards" in downtown sidewalks, identified in a recent sidewalk survey.

Thanks to new technology, the sidewalk should not be blocked for more than 20 minutes in any single location, according to Brian Christiansen, street superintendent.

The goal is to finish Friday, but work possibly could extend into Saturday.

Precision Concrete Cutting of Provo, Utah, is doing the work at a cost of \$19,550.
