Pay Utility Bills and Business License Fees Online

Xpress Bill Pay Now Available

KETCHUM, Idaho – Ketchum customers can now pay utility bills and business license fees online through Xpress Bill Pay. Online sales tax payments will soon be available.

Ketchum staff encouraged this service to create more efficiency in city departments. The service also offers faster and more convenient bill payment options for the city's customers.

A “Bill Payment” link to the service has been added to the city’s website. The service can also be accessed directly through xpressbillpay.com.

Eventually, the city will move towards monthly water billing, improving customers' ability to monitor water consumption.
