Registration Open for 10th Annual Idaho Pond Hockey Classic

Tournament to be held on Saturday and Sunday, Jan. 14 and 15

KETCHUM, Idaho — Registration is now open for the city of Ketchum's 10th Annual Idaho Pond Hockey Classic. The tournament is held at the Christina Potters Outdoor Ice Rink at Atkinson Park.

Cost is \$240 for each six-person team, and players must be at least 18. Only one person from each team is required to register.

The beginner and intermediate division starts Saturday at 9 a.m. and the advanced division, Sunday at 10 a.m. Food and beverages will be available throughout the competition.

Spectators are encouraged to watch more than 30 teams from five states compete.

"Come and watch hockey the way it originally was played – outdoors in the mountains," said John Kearney, city recreation supervisor.
