A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO ENCOURAGING PRIVATE COMPANIES TO EXPEDITE THE PROVISION OF DSL AND CABLE MODEM TECHNOLOGY SERVICES IN THE WOOD RIVER VALLEY.

WHEREAS today's economy is driven by technology and high speed access to the Internet, and

WHEREAS the Wood River Valley is in need of high speed data transmission for small business and residential customers, and

WHEREAS DSL (Digital Subscriber Line) technology is a technology that addresses the bandwidth needs of residential and small business users at an affordable price, and

WHEREAS a cable modem is a technology that also addresses the bandwidth needs of residential and small business users at an affordable price, and


WHEREAS companies currently operating in the Wood River Valley and those that are considering investing in the Valley expect the provision of such services, and
