A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, DECLARING SUPPORT FOR THE POLICIES OF PRESIDENT GEORGE W. BUSH RELATING TO THE NATION'S RESPONSE TO THE SEPTEMBER 11, 2001 ATTACK ON AMERICA.

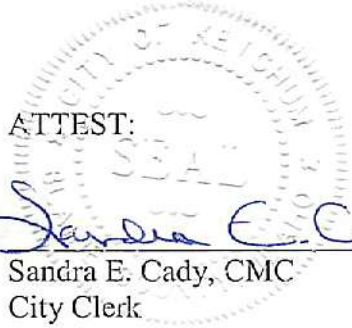
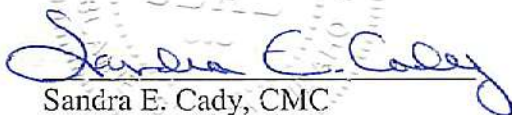
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:
