WHEREAS, City Council Resolutions have been numbered consecutively since the City was incorporated, and


WHEREAS, numbering City Council Resolutions to designate the year and the resolution number would assist the Mayor, Council, staff and the public with finding historical information and referencing City Council actions, and

WHEREAS, the transition from the old numbering system to the new will necessitate abandoning the following numbers that have already been assigned, but will not be used, 854, 856, 857, 859, 861, and 862, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that City Council Resolutions will be identified by the year and then numbered consecutively beginning this meeting and numbers will be assigned consecutively for the remainder of the calendar year, and commencing the first meeting in January 2003 and every succeeding January thereafter, the year designation will change and resolutions will be consecutively numbered for that particular year.

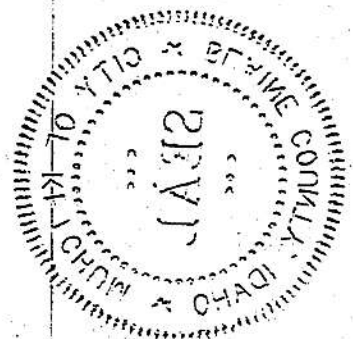
This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this 21st day of October, 2002.
