RESOLUTION 02-005

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE
MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH BLAINE COUNTY FOR THE
PEAK BUS SERVICE.

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum and Blaine County desire to enter into an agreement for the provision of administration, management and promotional services for the Peak Bus commuter bus service, and

WHEREAS, the people of Blaine County are faced with transportation investment decisions that will impact the long range character and economy of their communities, and

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum and Blaine County are facilitating these decisions through the development of a long-range transportation plan for the Highway 75 corridor, and

WHEREAS, recommended strategies for solving these traffic problems include a regularly scheduled peak-hour bus service in the Bellevue to Ketchum/Sun Valley corridor, and

WHEREAS, Blaine County has a contract with Sun Valley Express for the operations of the peak-hour bus service;

WHEREAS, Wood River Rideshare developed the schedule and route for the service and has provided the administrative support and promotion for the service prior to, and since, the June 3, 2002 launch of the service.

THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. CONTRACT: Blaine County hereby agrees to complete and perform administrative, management and promotional services for the Peak Bus commuter bus service for Blaine County, through independent contractors.

2. TERM OF AGREEMENT: The term of this agreement shall be from October 1, 2002, through and including September 30, 2003.

3. COMPENSATION: City of Ketchum agrees to pay Blaine County \$30,000.

4. REPORTS TO CITY: Blaine County shall submit quarterly reports to the City of Ketchum outlining the nature of services performed during the preceding quarter, including,

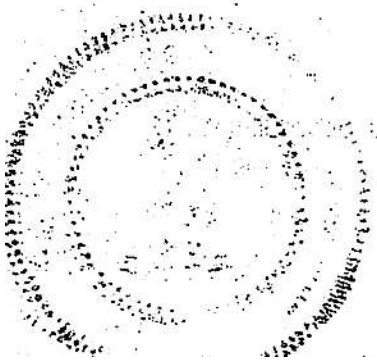


- Daily and monthly tracking of ridership
- Daily and monthly accounting of firebox revenue and pass sales
- Route and schedule monitoring
- Route and schedule updates and changes
- Advertising and promotion of the service, including but not limited to, newspaper ads, radio ads, bus schedules, and special promotions
- Coordination with area employers to increase ridership
- Coordination with cities and County on the location, installation, and improvements to bus stops, bus stop signs, park and ride lots, and bus shelters.

5. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS: COUNTY agrees to comply with all federal, state, county and municipal laws, rules and regulations in performance under this agreement.


6. TERMINATION. CITY or COUNTY may terminate this contract before the end of the term by providing sixty (60) days written notice from the Party desiring termination to the other Party.



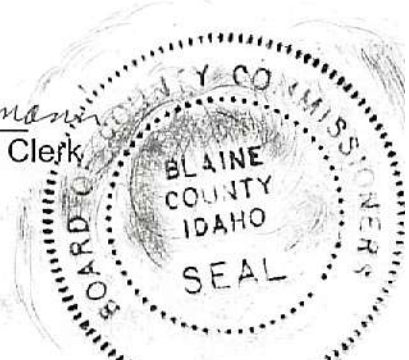
