## **RESOLUTION 02-007**

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL POLICE, FIRE, STREET, WATER AND WASTEWATER PERSONNEL AND REPEALING RESOLUTION 616

WHEREAS, the Ketchum City Council finds that the personnel of the police, fire, street, water and wastewater departments provide protection to the citizens of the City of Ketchum and their property from manor emergencies that require a quick response and mobilization of on-duty and on-call personnel, and

WHEREAS, the Ketchum City Council is committed to providing the maximum level protection to its citizens and those individuals who visit our city; and

WHEREAS, the Ketchum City Council finds it necessary to determine a reasonable response time to such emergencies by the above-stated personnel by restricting residency to a specifically defined area, and

WHEREAS, the Ketchum City Council finds that residences located within the area defined by the map, depicted as Exhibit A, enable personnel to respond to emergencies in a reasonable time frame, and

WHEREAS, this area is expanded from the previous requirement contained in Resolution 616,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Ketchum, that the principle place of residence for personnel of the police, fire, street, water and wastewater departments be limited to the geographic area depicted by the map contained as Exhibit A, and that Resolution 616, A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, PROVIDING A RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR ALL POLICE, FIRE, STREET, WATER AND WASTEWATER DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES, be repealed.

This Resolution with be in full force and effect upon its adoption this 21st day of October, 2002.
