WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum and the City of Sun Valley recognize the important contribution of arts and humanities to the quality of life in this community, and


WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum is interested in financially supporting a "non-specific study" of community needs, and


WHEREAS, the objective of this study is to determine what facilities are needed and can be supported by the community, regardless of location, as outlined by the specific scope of services found as Attachment A,
