

RESOLUTION NO. 828

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR A TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT GRANT FOR A SIDEWALK ON WARM SPRINGS ROAD FROM SIXTH STREET/STATE HIGHWAY 75 TO NINTH STREET/WARM SPRINGS ROAD.

WHEREAS, the Idaho Transportation Department, hereafter called the **STATE**, has issued a request for submittals for the Transportation Enhancement Grants; and

WHEREAS, the City has a goal of increasing pedestrian and motorist safety by completing a sidewalk from downtown Ketchum out Warm Springs Road; and


WHEREAS, the City Council discussed this item at their January 22, 2002 Council meeting, and agreed that the City should apply for a Transportation Enhancement Grant to assist in funding the missing sidewalk section from Sixth Street/State Highway 75 to Ninth Street/Warm Springs Road along Warm Springs Road; and

WHEREAS, the Council further discussed a local match for \$75,000 for the grant application, with funds to be available in 2004 for preliminary engineering, and construction in 2005.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the total cost of this project is estimated to be \$575,000, of which the City's share is \$75,000.
2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for the Fiscal Year 2005 Transportation Enhancement Grant for a sidewalk along Warm Springs Road from Sixth Street/State Highway 75 to Ninth Street/Warm Springs Road.
3. That the duly certified copies of the Resolution shall be furnished to the Idaho Transportation Department.
