

RESOLUTION NO. 833

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A NEW JOINT PARKING AGREEMENT WITH THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF THE BIGWOOD.

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2002, the Ketchum City Council passed Resolution No. 832, approving a proposal to reserve the existing Parking Lot located south of the Presbyterian Church for the exclusive use by the Skate Park, including No Parking for the Winter Season:



NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Ketchum, Idaho:




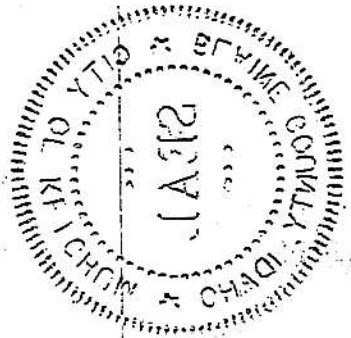
