CORY LYMAN AS POLICE CHIEF FOR THE CITY OF KETCHUM

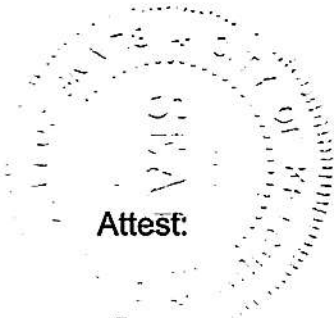
WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum conducted a nation-wide recruitment to fill the position of Police Chief, and

WHEREAS, the appointment of the Police Chief is the decision of the Mayor with the consent of the Ketchum City Council, and

WHEREAS, the selection process involved the Mayor, the City Council and a citizens panel who unanimously agreed that Cory Lyman was the most qualified candidate with the best fit with the City of Ketchum,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Cory Lyman be appointed as a the Chief of Police for the City of Ketchum with a starting salary of \$85,000 and that Mr. Lyman will be sworn in as chief at a later Council Meeting as he is expected to start in this capacity on February 1, 2003.

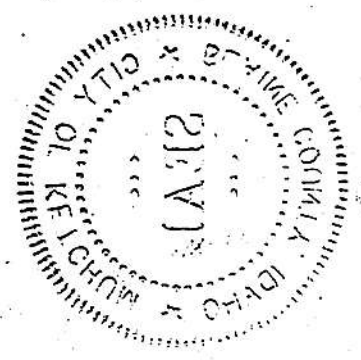
