

**RESOLUTION NO. 03-006**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR A TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT GRANT FOR A SIDEWALK ON STATE HIGHWAY 75 FROM SADDLE ROAD TO TENTH STREET.

**WHEREAS**, the Idaho Transportation Department, hereafter called the **STATE**, has issued a request for submittals for Transportation Enhancement Grants; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City has a goal of increasing pedestrian and motorist safety by completing a sidewalk from downtown Ketchum to Saddle Road; and,


**WHEREAS**, the City Council discussed this item at their January 21, 2003 Council meeting, and agreed that the City should apply for a Transportation Enhancement Grant to assist in funding the missing sidewalk section from Saddle Road to Tenth Street along State Highway 75; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Council further discussed a local match for \$50,000 for the grant application, with funds to be available in 2004 for preliminary engineering, and construction in 2006.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

1. That the total cost of this project is estimated to be \$550,000, of which the City's share is \$50,000.
2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for the Fiscal Year 2006 Transportation Enhancement Grant for a sidewalk along State Highway 75 from Saddle Road to Tenth Street.
3. That the duly certified copies of the Resolution shall be furnished to the Idaho Transportation Department.
