THE CITY OF KETCHUM


WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum conducted a nation-wide recruitment to fill the position of Planning Director, and

WHEREAS, the appointment of the Planning Director is the decision of the Mayor with the consent of the Ketchum City Council, and

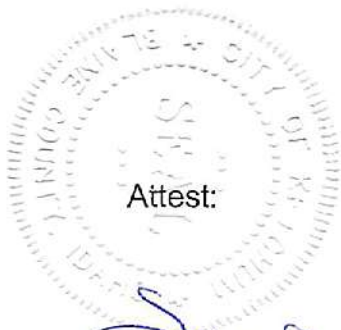
WHEREAS, the selection process involved the Mayor, the City Council and a citizens panel,

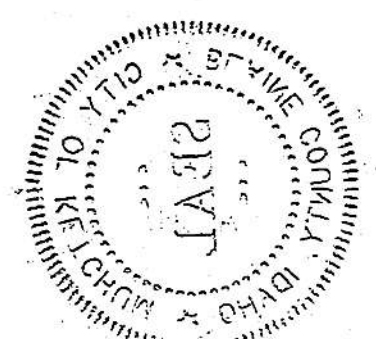
The Board of Directors, by a vote of 5-0, approved the purchase of the property for the sum of \$10,000.00, subject to the approval of the State of Alaska.

The Board of Directors, by a vote of 5-0, approved the execution of a deed conveying the property to the City of Ketchikan, Alaska, for the sum of \$10,000.00.

The Board of Directors, by a vote of 5-0, approved the execution of a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute the purchase agreement and deed on behalf of the City of Ketchikan, Alaska.
