WHEREAS, J&J Ventures, dba Tapestry, has proposed an art gallery that also serves beer and wine, and


WHEREAS, Tapestry is to be located at 680 4th Street East in the Christiana Building which is within 300 feet of a church, and

WHEREAS, section 23-913 of the Idaho Code provides that no liquor license be granted within 300 feet of any public school or church "except with the approval of the governing body of the municipality, and

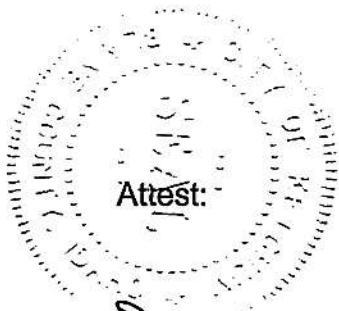
WHEREAS, the City Administrator has notified the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints that the City Council will consider this matter during the April 7 meeting of the City Council and that comments from the church are welcome on or before that time,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ketchum City Council waive the 300 foot requirement for a beer and wine license granted to J&J Ventures, dba Tapestry, at 680 4th Street East.

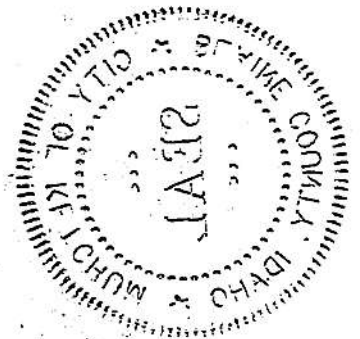
