RESOLUTION NO. 03-021

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT WITH THE IDAHO TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PEDESTRIAN CONNECTION FROM NINTH STREET TO SIXTH STREET ALONG WARM SPRINGS ROAD.

WHEREAS, the Idaho Transportation Department, hereafter called the STATE, has submitted an Agreement stating obligations of the STATE and the City of Ketchum, hereafter called the CITY, for design of the Warm Springs Bike Path Connector; and,

WHEREAS, the STATE is responsible for obtaining compliance with laws, standards and procedural policies in the development, construction and maintenance of improvements made to the Federal-aid Highway System when there is federal participation in the costs; and,

WHEREAS, certain functions to be performed by the STATE involve the expenditure of funds as set forth in the Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, the STATE can only pay for work associated with the State Highway system; and,

WHEREAS, the CITY is fully responsible for its share of project costs; and,

WHEREAS, the Warm Springs neighborhood is the largest residential neighborhood within the City limits; and,

WHEREAS, Warm Springs Road has been designated as a major collector and the construction of this pedestrian/bike path connection will improve public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the Agreement for Federal Aid Project STP-0700(102) is hereby approved.
- 2. That the Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the CITY.
- 3. That duly certified copies of the Resolution shall be furnished to the Idaho Transportation Department.
