

WHEREAS, the Ketchum-Sun Valley Area Transit Authority (KART) was established by the two cities to operate the transit system, and

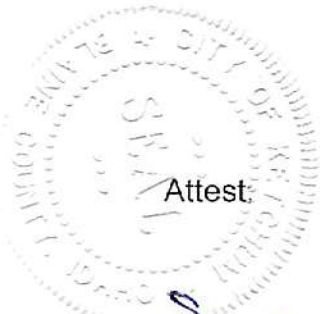
WHEREAS, the two cities are desirous of extending the interlocal agreement to operate KART for another 3 years,

**AGREEMENT EXTENDING THE
KETCHUM-SUN VALLEY PUBLIC TRANSIT AUTHORITY AGREEMENT**

THIS EXTENSION AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 11th day of December 2003, by and between the City of Ketchum, Idaho, a political subdivision of the State of Idaho ("Ketchum"), and the City of Sun Valley, Idaho, a political subdivision of the State of Idaho ("Sun Valley").

RECITIALS

WHEREAS, the parties hereto entered into an Agreement dated June 5, 1989 (the "Agreement"), pursuant to Idaho Code § 50-322 to purchase, lease or otherwise procure public transit systems, and to provide by general ordinance for the regulations governing the maintenance and operation of the same; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the Agreement pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 6, Duration, of the original Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Except as herein expressly provided to the contrary, the Agreement executed by the parties hereto on the 5th day of June, 1989, shall remain in full force and effect.
2. The term of commitment set forth in Paragraph 6 of the Agreement shall be extended and continued until 5:00 p.m., December 31, 2006.
3. In the event of the formation of a Regional Transportation Authority, or similar agency, then this Agreement may be renegotiated or dissolved by either City giving to the other City a sixty (60) day written notice to renegotiate the terms of the Agreement or dissolve the Agreement.

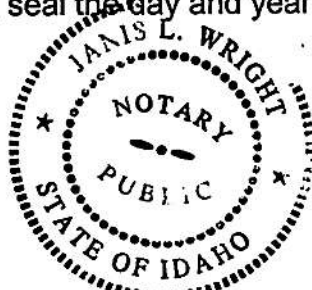
