

RESOLUTION NO. 04-024

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION AND REHABILITATION GRANT TO THE LOCAL HIGHWAY TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, the Idaho Transportation Department, through the Local Highway Technical Assistance Council (LHTAC), has issued a request for submittals for Transportation and Roadway Strategic Planning Grants; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum (City) wishes to provide for the well being and protect the quality of life of its people; and,

WHEREAS, the City has sustained steady growth for the past ten years, thereby causing an increase in traffic volumes; and,

WHEREAS, the City's Comprehensive Plan policy is to provide for safe and efficient traffic circulation; and,

WHEREAS, Warm Springs Road is critical to maintaining the viability of the Warm Springs Base area, neighborhood commercial area and access to public lands; and,


WHEREAS, the Warm Springs neighborhood is the largest residential neighborhood within the City limits; and,

WHEREAS, Warm Springs Road has been designated as a major collector and is eligible for consideration of this grant from LHTAC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The City of Ketchum, Idaho, supports the Warm Springs Road Rehabilitation Phase 1 project identification submittal for the Transportation and Roadway Strategic Planning project to the LHTAC.
2. The total cost of this project is estimated to be \$400,000, of which the City's share is \$29,360 or 7.34 percent.
3. The Mayor is directed to sign the project identification packet and submit to LHTAC for prioritization.

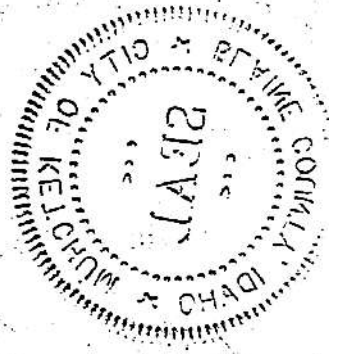
