#### **RESOLUTION NUMBER 04-028**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A SECOND AMENDMENT TO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE IDAHO TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING PLAN FOR THE CITY OF KETCHUM.

WHEREAS, the Idaho Transportation Department, hereafter called the STATE has submitted a second amendment to the original agreement with the City of Ketchum, hereafter called the CITY, for development of a transportation and parking management plan;

WHEREAS, the CITY previously entered into an agreement with the STATE, Federal Aid Highway Project STP-0004 (122), for the Downtown Ketchum Parking Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the STATE has amended the current agreement to include an additional presentation of the parking study to the City Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Ketchum, Idaho:

- 1. That the second amendment to the Agreement for Federal Aid Highway Project STP-0004 (122) is hereby approved.
- 2. That the Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the second amendment to the Agreement on behalf of the CITY.
- 3, That duly certified copies of this Resolution shall be furnished to the Idaho Transportation Department.

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

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# ADDENDUM TO STATE/LOCAL AGREEMENT STP-0700(102) WARM SPRINGS CONNECTOR, KETCHUM BLAINE COUNTY KEY N O. 8911

#### **PARTIES**

THIS ADDENDUM is made and entered into this 15th day of March , 2004, by and between the IDAHO TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT, hereafter called the STATE and the CITY OF KETCHUM, acting by and through its Mayor and Council, hereafter called the SPONSOR.

## **PURPOSE**

This Addendum will modify the State/Local Agreement for Project Development entered into on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June, 2003, between the same parties.

The parties agree as follows:

# SECTION I.

Paragraphs 1, 3 and 7 are revised to read as follows:

- It is necessary to develop construction plans and specifications in order that
  federal participation may be obtained in the construction costs of the project.
  Federal-aid for project development is not available on this project. The cost of
  project development is the SPONSOR's responsibility.
- 3. Scheduled funding for this project is listed on the approved Highway Development Program, and subsequent revisions. Current estimated funding is as follows:
  - a. Project Development (State, Consultant, Local) \$83,000 (Project Development is non-participating. \$80,000 will be moved to construction in the scheduled construction year.)
  - b. Right-of-Way \$-0-
  - c. Utilities \$-0-
  - d. Construction Engineering \$57,000
  - e. Construction \$435,000
  - f. Total Estimated Project Costs \$575,000



7. If the project is terminated by the SPONSOR prior to completion, and the SPONSOR has been reimbursed with federal funds for any project costs, the SPONSOR shall repay all federal funds

## **SECTION II:** That the **STATE** shall:

Paragraph 2.a. is deleted.

Paragraph 3 is deleted.

Paragraph 5 is revised to read as follows:


 Bill the SPONSOR for any federal funds to be repaid by the SPONSOR if the project is terminated by the SPONSOR prior to completion, and the SPONSOR has been reimbursed with federal funds for any project costs.

# **SECTION III:** That the **SPONSOR** shall:

Paragraph 4 is revised to read as follows:

 Hire a consultant to design the project, and make timely payment of all consultant invoices.

All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
