RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING
PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT INTOXILYZER FOR \$6,100
FROM POLICE TRUST FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Police Department currently uses a CMI 66 Intoxilyzer Alcohol Breath Testing Machine that was purchased in 1989, and

WHEREAS, CMI discontinued parts manufacturing for this model in 1999, making parts and service very difficult, and

WHEREAS, the current Intoxilyzer experienced a malfunction over the week end that has been determined not to be cost effective to repair and was placed out of service,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ketchum City Council authorizes the purchase of a CMI Intoxilyzer 5000 for \$6,100 and that the source of funds be from the Police Trust Fund.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this fifteenth (15th) day of March, 2004.
