RESOLUTION NUMBER 04-039

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, ESTABLISHING SPECIAL EVENT FEES FOR THE USE OF THE PARK AND RIDE LOT IN KETCHUM, IDAHO.

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the City of Ketchum establish a fee schedule for appropriate charges to persons and organizations that use the Park and Ride Lot for Special Events;

WHEREAS, such fees collected are to be used to reimburse the City for additional grounds maintenance costs caused by Special Events at the Park and Ride Lot; and,

WHEREAS, certain categories of events should be exempt from charging fees for the use of the Park and Ride Lot either because they:

- a. Only use a small portion of the Lot and, therefore, are not classified as a Special Event, or
- b. The Special Event is a fundraiser for a non-profit community based organization and such Special Events are in the public interest and should be encouraged by the City of Ketchum, or
- c. The Lot is used for parking for an event off-site.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Ketchum, Idaho that the charges for the use of the Park and Ride Lot for Special Events by persons and/or organizations are as follows:

- 1. No fee for use of the Lot for parking for an off-site event, or where only a small portion of the Lot is used and, therefore, not classified as a Special Event.
- 2. No fee for a Special Event that is a fundraiser for a non-profit community based organization.
- 3. For all other Special Events using the Park and Ride Lot, the fee to be charged is \$500 for the first day of the event and \$100 per day for additional days of the same event within the same calendar year.

The applicable fee for the use of the Park and Ride Lot for a Special Event shall be paid to the City prior to the issuance of the Special Event Permit as provided by Ketchum Ordinance Number 669.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all fees and charges established herein shall become effective on the effective date of this Resolution.
