A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT BIDS FOR STREET MATERIALS.

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum sent out letters to various companies requesting bids for street materials on a price per ton quote for any or all of the materials listed;

WHEREAS, bids from the following four companies were received:

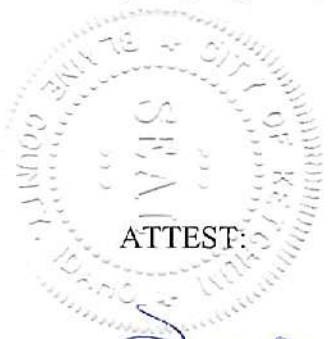
- Glendale Construction, Inc.
- Walker Sand and Gravel Ltd. Co.
- Lakeside Industries d.b.a. Valley Paving
- Anderson Asphalt Paving

WHEREAS, the Street Department desires to award the lowest bid of each of the four companies for the nine different materials specified, as listed in the schedule attached as "Exhibit A"; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum Street Department desires to reserve the right to reject any of the material that does not meet the Idaho Transportation Department and the City of Ketchum specifications as outlined in the request for bids letter.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ketchum City Council approves the lowest bids from the above mentioned companies and authorizes the Mayor to award the bids with the reservation that the City has the right to go to an alternate source of supply if the materials do not meet the listed specifications.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this nineteenth (19th) day of April, 2004.
