

RESOLUTION NUMBER 04-046

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT THE LOW BID FOR THE UV DISINFECTION, THE ELECTRICAL AND INSTRUMENTATION AND CONTROLS UPGRADE FOR THE KETCHUM/SUN VALLEY WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY.

WHEREAS, the Utilities Department has determined that certain improvements to the Ketchum/Sun Valley Wastewater Treatment Facility as called for in those certain Bidding Documents issued pursuant to the notice inviting bids for the Improvements published in the Idaho Mountain Express on March 17, 24, and 31, 2004 (the "Improvements") would upgrade systems for future capacity and would therefore meet more stringent permit limits; and

WHEREAS, the Utilities Department of the City of Ketchum published a notice inviting bids for the Improvements in the Idaho Mountain Express on March 17, 24, and 31, 2004; and

WHEREAS, bids for the Improvements from the following three companies were received:

The City Council of the City of Ketchum, Idaho approves the lowest bid of \$1,919,000.00 for the Improvements including without limitation, UV disinfection, electrical and instrumentation and controls upgrade for the Ketchum/Sun Valley Wastewater Treatment Facility, and authorizes the Mayor to award the bid to Spindler Construction Corp.


