

RESOLUTION NUMBER 04-089

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR A TEA-21 (TRANSPORTATION EFFICIENCY ACT FOR THE 21ST CENTURY) GRANT, BUS AND BUS-RELATED SECTION 5309, TO PLAN, DESIGN AND CONSTRUCT A MULTI-MODAL FACILITY ON THE CITY OF KETCHUM PARK AND RIDE LOT ADJACENT TO THE PROPOSED YMCA FACILITY

WHEREAS, the voters of Ketchum recently approved an advisory ballot to lease a portion of the Park and Ride property to the YMCA for 99 years at \$1.00 by a vote of 1,174 to 704, and

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum is interested in developing a multi-modal facility on this site to accommodate pedestrian, bicycle, vehicle and bus travel with the idea of promoting more transit ridership, and

WHEREAS, the Ketchum City Council has discussed the merits of securing federal funding from a Section 5309 grant,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council authorizes the 5309 grant application in the amount of \$1,423,390 for the above stated purposes.
