RESOLUTION NO. 04-096

THIS RESOLUTION NO. 04-096 is made by the City of Ketchum ("City") this 20th day of December 2004.

WHEREAS, the City owns real property commonly referred to as the Park and Ride Property; and

WHEREAS, the Wood River Community YMCA ("Wood River Y") has been planning and designing a recreational/cultural facility and raising capital for construction of such a facility, to be located on a portion of the Park and Ride Property; and

WHEREAS, the City and Wood River Y have been negotiating a Lease Agreement by which the Wood River Y will lease a portion of the Park and Ride Property from the City; and

WHEREAS, the Lease Agreement has not been finalized; and

WHEREAS, the Wood River Y has told the City that if the Lease Agreement cannot be finalized on this date, the Wood River Y would appreciate an indication of the City's intent to enter into the Lease Agreement when it is finalized in order to assist the Wood River Y in its fund raising efforts during the holiday season; and

WHEREAS, the City is willing to communicate its intent to enter into the Lease Agreement with the Wood River Y on the terms and conditions set forth in this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City will enter into the Lease Agreement with the Wood River Y as follows:

- 1. When the Lease Agreement is finalized with terms and conditions acceptable to the City, including the provision of a proper legal description of the property to be leased, in substantially the same form as that certain draft Lease Agreement referred to as "Original Document dated 12-11-04 and Revised Document dated 12-14-04", the City will enter into the Lease Agreement as revised.
- 2. The City will make a good faith effort to finalize the revisions to the draft Lease Agreement in an expeditious manner.
- 3. The Mayor is authorized to execute the final Lease Agreement upon approval by the City Attorney.


