WHEREAS, the Police Department recently lost one of its canines, Gotcha, to illness after a long, distinguished career with the department, and


WHEREAS, Officer Derek Stewart researched the efficacy of replacing the canine as well as options for procurement and training, and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds exist in the Police Trust Fund and those funds may be used for this purpose, and

WHEREAS, the one time cost to acquire, equip and train (both canine and officer) are estimated to be \$6,350; and the annual expense to maintain the canine is estimated to be \$2,025,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ketchum City Council appropriated \$8,375 from the Police Trust Fund to acquire, equip and train an additional canine.
