
A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICE REGARDING THE FY2005 CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT PROGRAM, IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,500 OR 50% OF ELIGIBLE COSTS, WHICHEVER IS LESS, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum is a Certified Local Government and participates in and qualifies for a variety of state and federal grant programs that support historic preservation, and

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum, through the hard work of the Historic Preservation Office, has been awarded a grant from the FY2005 Certified Local Government Grant Program in the amount not to exceed \$2,500 or 50% of the eligible costs, whichever is less,


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council approves the Memorandum of Agreement with the State Historic Preservation Office and authorizes the Mayor to execute said document on behalf of the City of Ketchum.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this twenty-second (22nd) day of February, 2005.
