RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM CITY COUNCIL WAIVING THE EXISTING POLICY AND AUTHORIZING 2 HOUR PARKING ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF FIRST STREET FOR THE ENTIRE BLOCK BETWEEN MAIN STREET AND WASHINGTON STREET


WHEREAS, the City received a request from First Bank of Idaho for two hour parking on First Street, and

WHEREAS, the City is in the process of revising the existing policy for posting parking restrictions and replacing it with a new policy that delegates this responsibility to a staff committee, and

WHEREAS, the City Council waives the requirements of the existing policy including notice to neighboring properties,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ketchum City Council waives the existing policy for posting parking restrictions and authorizes 2 hour parking on the south side of First Street for the entire block between Main Street and Washington Street.
