

RESOLUTION NUMBER 05-049

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, ADOPTING THE NATIONAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM ("NIMS") AS CURRENTLY SET FORTH BY THE SECRETARY OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE WITH HOMELAND SECURITY PRESIDENTIAL DIRECTIVE (HSPD -5) AND AS SUCH SYSTEM MAY BE MODIFIED FROM TIME TO TIME.

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2003, the President of the United States of America issued Homeland Security Presidential Directive ("HSPD-5") directing the Secretary of Homeland Security (the "Director") to develop and administer a National Incident Management System ("NIMS") intended to provide a consistent nationwide approach for Federal, State, and local governments to work effectively and efficiently together to prepare for, respond to, and recover from domestic incidents, regardless of cause, size, or complexity, and

WHEREAS, the Director has set forth the plan for such development and administration of the NIMS in that certain publication of the Department of Homeland Security dated March 1, 2004, entitled "National Incident Management System"; and

WHEREAS, HSPD-5 requires Federal departments and agencies to make adoption of the NIMS by local governments a condition for Federal preparedness assistance beginning in FY 2005; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of and visitors to the City to adopt and participate in the NIMS and obtain such preparedness assistance.

WHEREAS, each of the parties has appropriate equipment and trained personnel necessary to provide such services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ketchum hereby finds that a joint exercise of powers agreement is necessary to conserve resources and to protect and promote the public health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Ketchum.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Ketchum, Idaho, that the city hereby adopts the National Incident Management System ("NIMS") as currently set forth by the Secretary of Homeland Security in accordance with Homeland Security Presidential Directive (HSPD -5) and as such system may be modified from time to time.


