RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO
REJECTING THE BID FOR THE DOWNTOWN WATER MAIN PROJECT
AND DIRECTING STAFF TO RE-BID THE PROJECT NEXT YEAR

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum adopted a Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) to better coordinate projects throughout the city and the priority of the CIP is a phased Downtown Streetscape project that includes sidewalks and pedestrian lighting in the Community Core, and

WHEREAS, the old Ketchum Spring water system needs to be replaced in coordination with the Downtown Streetscape project, and


WHEREAS, the first phase of the Downtown Water Main Project was designed by JUB Engineering and put out to bid, and

WHEREAS, only one bid was received from KD Excavation and that bid was above the Engineer's estimate for the project, and

WHEREAS, JUB Engineering, the Utilities Manager, and the City Administrator all concur that the project should be re-bid next spring,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF KETCHUM, IDAHO that the bid is rejected and that staff is directed to re-bid the project next year.


This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this 6th (sixth) day of September, 2005.


