WHEREAS, Sun Valley Chauffeur, LLC has requested to transfer such franchise to Important Ventures, LLC; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to Ketchum Municipal Code §5.08.050, no franchise or license may be transferred without the written approval and consent of the Council; and

WHEREAS, Sun Valley Chauffeur, LLC requested such written approval and consent.




