RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM CITY COUNCIL AWARDING A BID FOR A PICK UP TRUCK FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT VEHICLE TO BLUE LAKES FORD, TWIN FALLS, IDAHO, FOR \$29,234, APPROVING A LIST OF VEHICLE OPTIONS NOT TO EXCEED \$4,000, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO AWARD THE BID

WHEREAS, in the FY2006 Budget the Fire Department budgeted for the replacement of the pick up truck assigned as the Technical Services Unit vehicle, and


WHEREAS, the anticipated budget for this replacement was \$34,500 funded 50/50 with the Ketchum Rural Fire District, and

WHEREAS, bids were obtained per the most current State of Idaho purchasing guidelines (see attached Purchase Quotation Form), and

WHEREAS, the budget also provides funds to outfit the vehicle with a variety of attachments and options to be obtained and installed by a variety of vendors as well as duty fire staff (see attached 2006 Pickup Options Costs sheet) and that these options will not exceed \$4,000,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ketchum City Council awards the bid to Blue Lakes Ford, Twin Falls, Idaho, for \$29,234, approves the installation of vehicle options not to exceed \$4,000, and authorizes the Mayor to execute the bid award.

This Resolution with be in full force and effect upon its adoption this fifth (5th) day of December, 2005.




