RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM CITY COUNCIL IN SUPPORT OF A FY2009 SYSTEM ENHANCEMENT GRANT APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$243,000 TO CONSTRUCT AND INSTALL BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS ON 4TH STREET TO TIE INTO THE WOOD RIVER TRAIL SYSTEM, AND THAT THE MAYOR BE AUTHORIZED TO SUBMIT THE GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum has completed Phase 1 of its Downtown Master Plan which identifies the need to develop 4^{th} Street as a pedestrian corridor that is also friendly and safe for bicycle traffic, and

WHEREAS, the City's Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) includes phased projects to construct and upgrade sidewalks, create new streetscapes, and improve pedestrian lighting in the Community Core that is consistent with this grant application, and

WHEREAS, the amount requested from this grant is \$243,000, which requires a local match of \$16,000, already budgeted in the CIP, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ketchum City Council supports a FY2009 System Enhancement Grant Application in the amount of \$243,000 to construct and install bicycle and pedestrian improvements on 4th Street to tie into the Wood River Trail System, and that the Mayor is authorized to submit the grant application.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this sixth (6th) day of February, 2006.
