RESOLUTION NUMBER 06-041

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT AMONG THE KETCHUM POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE BLAINE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND POSSIBLY OTHER BLAINE COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES TO INCLUDE, THE SUN VALLEY POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE HAILEY POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE BELLEVUE MARSHALL'S OFFICE, GOVERNING THE CREATION AND THE TERMS OF USE AND FUNDING OF A RECORD MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (RMS).

WHEREAS, a networked RMS in Blaine County would greatly enhance the ability of the County's law enforcement agencies to cooperate, share resources and assist each other thereby improving law enforcement services throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, the Ketchum Police Department and the Blaine County Sheriff's office received certain funds from forfeiture trust funds held in trust for various expenditures intended to improve law enforcement services in Blaine County; and

WHEREAS, such funds may be used for the purchase the equipment and services necessary to install the RMS and make it operational; and

WHEREAS, such funds may not be used for the administration and day to day expenses of the RMS; and

WHEREAS, the law enforcement agencies which will use and benefit from the RMS desire to enter a joint powers agreement pursuant to Idaho Code § 67-2328 governing the terms of use and funding of the administration and day to day use of the RMS.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Ketchum, Idaho that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a joint powers agreement among The Ketchum Police Department, The Blaine County Sheriff's Office and possibly other Blaine County law enforcement agencies to include, The Sun Valley Police Department, The Hailey Police Department and the Bellevue Marshall's Office, governing the creation and the terms of use and funding of a Record Management System (RMS).

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this 3rd day of April,

2006.
