

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 06-064**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS AND THE CITY OF KETCHUM FOR EMERGENCY FLOOD ASSISTANCE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code §50-301, Ketchum is empowered to enter into contracts as may be deemed necessary to promote the public health, safety, and welfare of Ketchum and its residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, Public Law 99, 84<sup>th</sup> Congress, as amended, provides a means of preparing for a combating damage by flood and flood waters; and


WHEREAS, on the date of this resolution, emergency flood preparation is needed and assistance required for this purpose as well as for flood fighting and rescue operations; and

WHEREAS, Ketchum has requested the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to furnish assistance in flood emergency preparation and in flood fighting and rescue operations.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Ketchum, Idaho that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a Cooperation Agreement between the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the City of Ketchum for emergency flood assistance.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this 1<sup>st</sup> day of May, 2006.


