A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO
AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES FROM THE POLICE TRUST FUND IN THE
AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$100,000 TO DESIGN AND CONSTRUCT A
CARPORT.

WHEREAS, the Police Trust Account requires City Council authorization and the
consent of the Chief of Police in order to legally expend funds, and


WHEREAS, the Chief is recommending the use of Police Trust funds to design and
construct a carport at the rear entrance to the Police Department as a means of correcting a
winter safety hazard for employees and to protect police vehicles from snow sliding off the
neighbor's roof, and

WHEREAS, Living Architecture has been selected to perform the design of this
structure, which will require fire sprinklers,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ketchum City Council
authorizes expenditures from the Police Trust Fund in the amount not to exceed \$100,000
to design and construct a carport.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this 21st day of
August, 2006.


