**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM CITY COUNCIL AWARDING A
BID TO BURKES EXCAVATION FOR WATER LINES IN ATKINSON PARK IN
THE AMOUNT OF \$84,500, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO AWARD
THE CONTRACT**

WHEREAS, the Water Department Facilities Study identifies the need to replace a water line that bisect the athletic fields in Atkinson Park, and

WHEREAS, the project was designed and bid by the Forsgren Associates, the city engineer, according to public bid statutes, and

WHEREAS, three bids were submitted and that Burkes Excavation was the low bid, and

WHEREAS, Burkes Excavation has completed work for the city previously, including the Downtown Water Line Replacement Project with excellent results,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ketchum City Council awards the bid from Burkes Excavation for the Atkinson Park Water Line in the amount of \$84,500, and that the Mayor is authorized to execute the bid award.
