

RESOLUTION NUMBER 06-116

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO,
AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF THE CITY SEWER LINE TO LOTS 15-20,
MORTGAGE ROW SUBDIVISION.

WHEREAS, lots 15-20 of the Mortgage Row Subdivision are currently served by individual septic tanks; and

WHEREAS, on September 18, 2006, the City Council approved the emergency sewer hook-up to the Graves residence, located at lot 20, which has a failed septic tank and will not be functional through another winter; and

WHEREAS, Pharmer Engineering, LLC was asked to and has determined the feasibility of constructing sewer lines capable of servicing lots 15-20 into the Ketchum Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, the Utilities Department has budgeted \$64,200 for this project in the 2006-07 Wastewater Collections budget; and

WHEREAS, the project is now only expected to cost approximately \$40,000; and

WHEREAS, the City desires and has deemed it in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare to extend the sewer line to lots 15-20.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Ketchum, Idaho that the City Council hereby authorizes the extension of the City sewer line to lots 15-20, Mortgage Row Subdivision.


This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this 2nd day of October 2006.
