RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM CITY COUNCIL APPROVING CITY REIMBURSEMENT OF ENGINEERING FEES FOR A RESIDENTIAL UNDERGROUNDING PROJECT, AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT TO LYNN T. LEVY, MD AND JOANN LEVY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$ 5,040.

WHEREAS, the voters of Ketchum approved increasing the franchise fee on electricity to 3% to fund undergrounding of overhead lines, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has given priority to the Community Core and approved a policy for reimbursing the cost of residential under grounding projects including the direct reimbursement of the engineering feasibility study, and

WHEREAS, Lynn T. "Buck" Levy and Joann Levy paid Idaho Power the sum of \$5,040 for the purpose of conducting an underground feasibility study along the western reaches of Warm Springs Road, approximately from Sage Road to the Ketchum City Limits,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ketchum City Council authorizes the expenditure of \$5,040 as reimbursement to Lynn T. "Buck" Levy and Joann Levy for incurring the cost of the Idaho Power feasibility study.
