CURRAN IN THE AMOUNT OF \$ 720.


WHEREAS, the voters of Ketchum approved increasing the franchise fee on electricity to 3% to fund undergrounding of overhead lines, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has given priority to the Community Core and approved a policy for reimbursing the cost of residential under grounding projects including the direct reimbursement of the engineering feasibility study, and

WHEREAS, Peter Curran paid Idaho Power the sum of \$ 720 for the purpose of conducting an underground feasibility study to underground the service to his property at 208 Broadway Blvd. ,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ketchum City Council authorizes the expenditure of \$ 720 as reimbursement to Peter Curran for incurring the cost of the Idaho Power feasibility study.




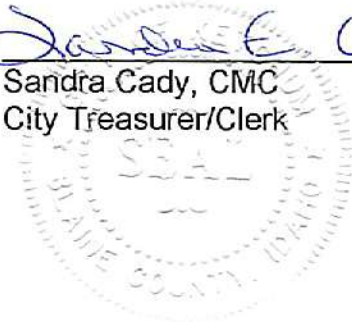

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Board of Directors of the City of Ketchikan, Alaska, has received a request from the Ketchikan Chamber of Commerce for a public hearing on the proposed ordinance regarding the regulation of commercial fishing vessels in the city harbor.

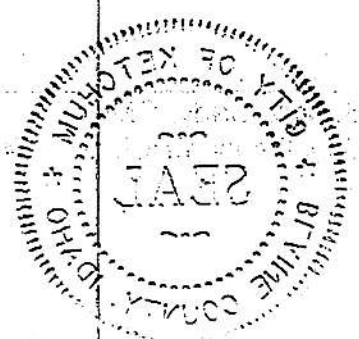
The proposed ordinance is intended to address the increasing number of commercial fishing vessels operating in the harbor and the resulting congestion and safety concerns. The ordinance would require all commercial fishing vessels to obtain a permit from the city and to adhere to specific operating procedures, including designated berthing areas and restricted operating hours.

The public hearing will be held on the 15th day of August, 2024, at 7:00 PM, in the City Council Chamber, located at 100 West 1st Street, Ketchikan, Alaska. The hearing will be open to the public, and anyone wishing to comment on the proposed ordinance is encouraged to attend.

The Board of Directors will consider the proposed ordinance at the public hearing and may choose to amend, approve, or reject the ordinance. The Board's decision will be final and subject to appeal to the Ketchikan Municipal Court.
