

RESOLUTION NUMBER 06-133

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO AUTHORIZING AND INSTRUCTING THE MAYOR TO RETIRE KETCHUM POLICE K-9, CHESTER, AND SELL HIM TO KETCHUM POLICE OFFICER, FORREST DANILSON, IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00).

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Ketchum Police Department that Chester is unable to perform his duties as a Police K-9 for the Ketchum Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Ketchum Police Officer, Forrest Danilson, has expressed an interest in acquiring Chester after Chester retires from being a police K-9 for the Ketchum Police Department; and


WHEREAS, Forrest Danilson has shown great dedication to the Ketchum Police Department and is considered a highly valued employee; and

WHEREAS, Assistant Police Chief, Mike McNeil, recommends that the City sell Chester to Forrest Danilson upon Chester's retirement from the Ketchum Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Ketchum, Idaho, that the City Council hereby authorizes and instructs the Mayor to retire Ketchum Police K-9, Chester, and sell him to Ketchum Police Officer, Forrest Danilson, in the amount of one dollar (\$1.00).


This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this 4th day of December, 2006.


