

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 07-010**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN ADDENDUM TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF KETCHUM AND CHRISTINA POTTERS, AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF \$465 PER MONTH FOR HEALTHCARE EXPENSES TO GO DIRECTLY TO HER.


WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 05-041, the City of Ketchum entered an agreement with Christina Potters, accepting her resignation and agreeing to pay approximately \$465 per month towards her healthcare coverage; and

WHEREAS, Christina Potters has new health care coverage which is paid directly by Potters.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Ketchum, Idaho, that the City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute an addendum to the agreement between the City and Christina Potters, authorizing payment of \$465 for healthcare expenses to go directly to her.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this second (2<sup>nd</sup>) day of January 2007.


