

RESOLUTION 07-020

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE PROJECT IDENTIFICATION PACKET AND SUBMIT IT TO THE LOCAL HIGHWAY TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE COUNCIL (LHTAC) FOR PRIORITIZATION, SUPPORTING THE CITY-WIDE TRANSPORTATION MODEL AND SH-75 ALTERNATE ROUTE STUDY, WHICH WILL REQUIRE LOCAL MATCHING FUNDS FROM THE CITY OF KETCHUM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$22,020.


WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum completed a transportation study on April 30, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum has a six-year Capital Improvement Program that contains all transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum recognizes the need for a traffic model to analyze capital improvement requests.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ketchum City Council authorizes and directs the Mayor to sign the project identification packet and submit it to LHTAC for prioritization, supporting the city-wide transportation model and SH-75 alternate route study, which will require local matching funds from the City of Ketchum in an amount not to exceed \$22,020.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this fifth (5th) day of February, 2007.




