RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM CITY COUNCIL REPEALING RESOLUTION 06-140 AND APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT WITH THE WOOD RIVER IDAHO PARENT-TEACHER-STUDENT ASSOCIATION (IPTSA), AUTHORIZING \$1,000 FOR A SUBSTANCE FREE GRADUATION PARTY FOR THE WOOD RIVER HIGH SCHOOL CLASS OF 2007.

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum traditionally funds the annual substance free graduation party for Wood River High School, and

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum approved the Fiscal Year 2007 Budget which included sufficient funds in the Police Trust Fund account to cover these expenses; and

WHEREAS, on December 4, 2006, the Mayor and Council passed Resolution No. 06-140, which authorized the Mayor to sign an agreement with Blaine County School District Education Foundation and authorized the expenditure of \$1,000 from the Police Trust fund; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum was informed that if such funds were given to the Blaine County School District Education Foundation, ten percent (10%) would be deducted for administrative costs; and

WHEREAS, if the City of Ketchum presents the Wood River IPTSA with the \$1,000, the entire amount will be used for the substance-free graduation party for the Wood River High School Class of 2007.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ketchum City Council hereby repeals resolution 06-140 and approves and authorizes the Mayor to sign an agreement with the Wood River IPTSA and authorizes the expenditure of \$1,000 from the Police Trust Fund for a substance-free graduation party for the Wood River High School Class of 2007.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this 4th day of December, 2006.
