

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 07-041**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO ACCEPTING A BID FROM ERWIN EXCAVATION FOR THE FOURTH STREET HERITAGE CORRIDOR IN THE AMOUNT OF \$746,851.64 AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO AWARD THE BID

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Downtown Master Plan that was approved by the City Council with Resolution No. 06-097 on September 8, 2006, a set of initiatives which includes physical improvements such as a Fourth Street Heritage Corridor should be implemented; and

WHEREAS, this project was bid in compliance with Idaho Code § 67-2309; and


WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum received two (2) bids from local companies that are familiar with designing and constructing a pedestrian-priority street; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that Erwin Excavation has such skills and expertise to complete the project.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ketchum City Council accepts a bid for the Fourth Street Heritage Corridor from Erwin Excavation in the amount of \$746,851.64 and that the Mayor be authorized to award the bid.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this second (2<sup>nd</sup>) day of April, 2007.


