

RESOLUTION NUMBER 07-052

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KETCHUM, IDAHO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR SERVICES WITH THE BLAINE COUNTY SENIOR COUNCIL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,500 TO PROVIDE MEALS AND TRANSPORTATION SERVICES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code Section 50-301, Ketchum has the authority to enter into contracts with outside agencies to provide services which are reasonably necessary to maintain the peace and promote the public health, safety and welfare of Ketchum's residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the Ketchum City Council adopted Resolution 03-068, establishing policies and procedures regarding outside agency requests to enter such contracts to provide such services; and

WHEREAS, the Blaine County Senior Council is such an outside agency, has satisfied the requirements of such policies and procedures and has offered to contract with Ketchum to provide meals and transportation services in exchange for \$2,500 to pay for part of the cost of such services; and


WHEREAS, Ketchum approved the Fiscal Year 2006-07 Budget, which included an amount for the purpose of funding such contract with the Blaine County Senior Council; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare to contract with the Blaine County Senior Council to provide meals and transportation services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Ketchum, Idaho that the City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute a contract for services with the Blaine County Senior Council in the amount of \$2,500 to provide meals and transportation services.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this second (2nd) day of April 2007.

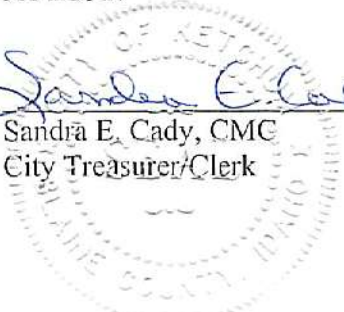

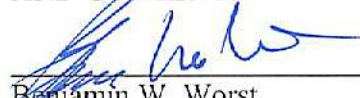
