A RESOLUTION OF THE KETCHUM CITY COUNCIL APPROVING A TEMPORARY RIGHT OF WAY ENCROACHMENT ON 4TH STREET AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO CONSTRUCT A TEMPORARY PATIO IN THE RIGHT OF WAY

WHEREAS, the City Council has approved and funded the initial two block segment of the 4th Street Heritage Corridor between Walnut Avenue and Leadville Avenue; and


WHEREAS, the City Council has awarded a contract with Erwin Excavating for this project and that work began on April 9; and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the need to enhance the appearance of the entrance to 4th Street from Main Street and to further develop pedestrian friendly facilities in the block between Main Street and Leadville Avenue, and

WHEREAS, the temporary patio will be (1) constructed from materials that will be re-used in other projects, and (2) installed primarily by City Street Department crews (see attached design),

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Ketchum City Council that the City of Ketchum approves a temporary right of way encroachment on the north side of 4th Street between Leadville Avenue and the alley, and directs the City Administrator to construct a temporary patio in the right of way.

This Resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this sixteenth (16th) day of April 2007.


