

RESOLUTION NUMBER 07-92

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF KETCHUM, IDAHO, APPOINTING
BILL LEHMAN TO THE KETCHUM HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum, under the provisions of Idaho Code 67-4603, adopted ordinance 511 in 1989 establishing a Historic Preservation Commission; and,

WHEREAS, Tory Canfield, a local land use planner, fulfilled a three (3) year term on the Ketchum Historic Preservation Commission which expired February 1, 2007 and does not wish to serve another term; and


WHEREAS, a vacancy exists on the Ketchum Historic Preservation and the City of Ketchum requested letters of interest in serving on the Historic Preservation Commission and published a display ad on the Idaho Mountain Express on April 4, 2007 and April 11, 2007; and

WHEREAS, Bill Lehman, a Ketchum resident, submitted a letter of interest demonstrating his interest in historic preservation and serving on the Ketchum Historic Preservation Commission.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of Ketchum, Idaho that Bill Lehman be appointed to the Ketchum Historic Preservation Commission for a three (3) year term expiring February 1, 2010.

This resolution will be in full force and effect upon its adoption this 2nd day of July, 2007.
